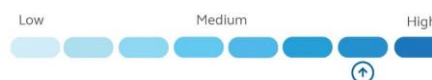
Investment Objective

Fund Manager's Comment

In July 2024, the MSCI ASEAN Index (MISO) increased by 3.3%. Singapore and Malaysia were the top performer driven by Singapore Telecommunication and Tenaga Nasional Bhd. On contrary, Thailand and Indonesia recorded negative return. Bangkok Dusit, Telkom Indonesia and Unilever Indonesia were among the worst performers due to its weak second quarter results.

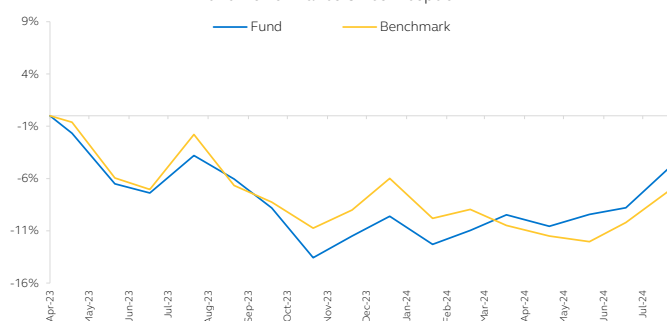

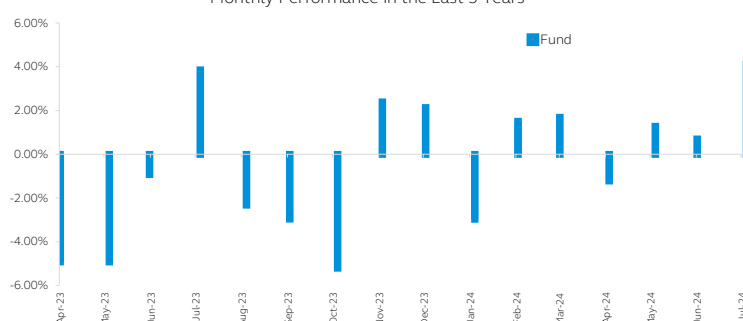
